

WILLIAM BERRY ROAD REHABILITATION

As you may already have noticed, Council are carrying out construction works at the intersection of William Berry Drive and Dickson Road, Morayfield. The full project works are scheduled to be completed by mid/late 2025, weather permitting.

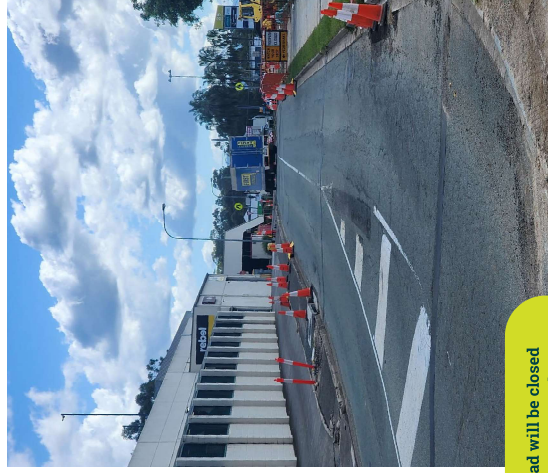
OVERVIEW OF WORKS

Key improvements will involve:

- Reconfiguration of intersection approaches to improve lane designations
- Widening of Dickson Road to provide a left and right turn lane from Dickson Road into William Berry Drive
- Reconfiguration of the existing zebra crossing and installation of three pedestrian refuges
- Removal and reconstruction of the retaining wall on the western side of Dickson Road
- Construction of a 2 metre wide pathway, associated plantings of street trees and street lighting.

HOW YOU WILL BE AFFECTED

- Council will make every effort to minimise noise and other impacts on surrounding properties.
- Works are generally scheduled during daytime hours, between 7.00 AM to 6.00 PM. Council have planned night works as part of the project and they will advise of these in future updates.
- Due to the nature of works, traffic flow may be affected. Please observe the instructions of work crews and road signage and plan your travel.



This section of road will be closed from 11 May for approx. a week.

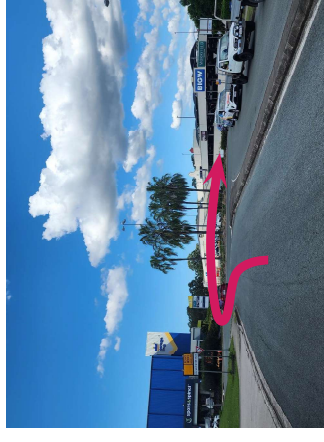
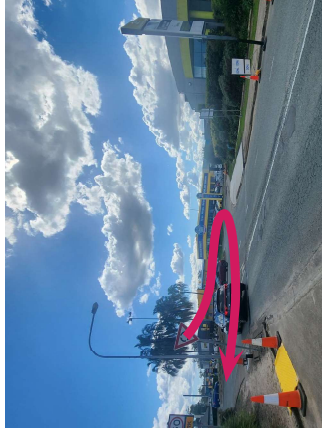
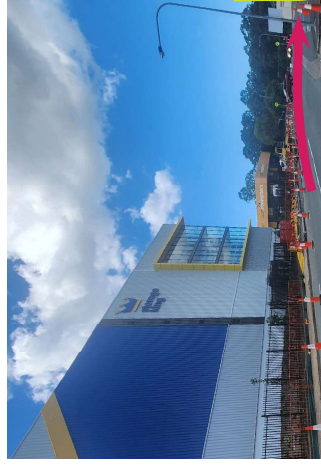
NEXT STAGE

IMPORTANT TO NOTE FROM 11 MAY

Works have been delayed due to recent wet weather/cyclone. As a result of these recent weather events, the council engineer has deemed the original design not suitable and has now established another plan.

- Deeper excavations are now required along William Berry drive from Big W end of Centre to car park entrance and also up Dixon Road finishing past Cash Converters.
- Energex have also been delayed due to the above fact to complete works in May.
- **Council are looking at closing the whole T section at Dixon Road and William Berry Drive for roughly a week, possibly longer 11 May PM between the bend in William Berry Drive and the red rooster roundabout.**
- For these works they will be unable to do night works as the material required can only be picked up from quarries during the day (closed at night).
- The Rebel loading dock will have some limitations with access due to works by both council and Energex.
- **Pedestrians and all other vehicles will not be able to get through.**

- Council are providing traffic controllers. Traffic will be redirected as follows:
- Traffic from Morayfield Road will be redirected at the Red Rooster roundabout to travel along Leda Blvd during some of this closure period.



- Traffic from behind the Centre/William Berry Drive will be redirected from near the undercover car park entrance under Big W at the back of the centre facing the railway line.
- The ground level car park of the Centre (with entrance from William Berry Drive opposite Storage King) **will be closed overnight from Fri 16 May at 7pm to Saturday 17 May 6am.** Council will supply a traffic controller to control carpark traffic. Please note that all dates and times are subject to change and will be confirmed by Council.
- Council have also assured us that this will not impact School Holidays commencing 28 June weather pending (unless we get more unforeseen extreme weather).

The car park which you can see access to on the right will be closed from 7pm on Friday 16th May to 6am Saturday 17 May.
